Flocons de Sel 04 50 21 49 99

2 Michelin stars. Excellent food, nice ambience not too formal. Degustation menu takes a strong stomach, a la carte is easier to digest! It is up the road past the Rochebrune cable car – you will need transport.

Flocons Villages 04 50 78 35 01

Excellent food and very reasonably priced. We highly recommend it. Up the back street near the Jazz Club

St. Georges Hotel – Table du Trappeur & Table du Pecheur 04 50 93 07 15

Two restaurants. The table du Trappeur is a favourite with good French food, although service can be slow. Nice ambience. Two sittings 6:30 and 8:30pm. Table du Pecheur specialises in fish and good plat du jour but does have other dishes.

Au Coeur de Megeve Hotel 04 50 21 25 30

This 3 star hotel has a cosy and charming restaurant serving good food. Good home made aperitifs. Two sittings 6:30 and 8:30pm Comfortable bar

Puck 04 50 21 06 61

Two restaurants, one downstairs and one upstairs. Quite trendy. Food was average – more snacky than evening meal probably more suited for lunch. Good for a crepe after skiing otherwise not recommended.

Le Chamois

Good for Savoyard specialties. Excellent tartiflette & plat du jour. Nice wooden, chalet style restaurant and friendly owner – Eric Bartozzi. In central square. Can't book.

Delicium 04 50 21 37 15

Convenient for those staying at Rochebrune. Pizza and pasta. Latest reports are that service is bad.

Chez Tante Alice 04 50 58 71 31

Interesting menu. Pleasant ambience and good and friendly service.

La Demi Lune 04 50 93 00 87

Out of town on the route nationale. Very well decorated and charming couple that run this restaurant. Good food – set menus.

Enfants Terribles 04 50 21 20 02

Next to Hotel Mont Blanc. Savoyard specialties or French cooking. Very expensive.

Grenier de Megeve 04 50 21 47 81

Opposite Hotel St. Georges. Traditional, small and charming restaurant. Like sitting in your front room by the fire. Good food. Book early.

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Le Baroque

Good for families. Inexpensive – pizzas, pasta, fondu etc.

Le Bistrot 04 50 21 32 74

Good value for traditional Savoyard cooking – fondu, Pierre chaud etc. Near Au Coeur de Megeve.

Cintra 04 50 21 02 60

Seafood restaurant in the centre. Excellent food but poor service.

L'Esquinade

Very expensive but good food – not traditional, a lot of Asian cuisine. Near Hotel Au Vieux Moulin.

Le Prieure 04 50 21 01 7

We found this expensive and disappointing the last time we went. Service is good and nice atmosphere.

Torrent 04 50 58 92 21

Good food. Try and get a table overlooking the stream

La Sauvageonne “Chez Nano” 04 50 91 90 81

Expensive and out of town at the end of the Route de Rochebrune but good food and lovely scenery. Possibly a lunch destination for non-skiers. Now owned by the owners of the Alpette restaurant

Le Serac 04 50 93 80 50

In St. Gervais – you would need to take a taxi. Trying for a Michelin star so food is fantastic and still at a reasonable price – get in soon! Service can be slow.
