Flocons de Sel 04 50 21 49 99

Emmanuel Renaut now has 3 Michelin stars. Excellent food, nice ambience not too formal. Degustation menu takes a strong stomach, a la carte is easier to digest! It is up the road past the Rochebrune cable car – you will need transport. Check taxi fare before.

Flocons Villages 04 50 78 35 01

Excellent food and very reasonably priced. Up the back street near the Jazz Club. Main course €23-32 with a menu at €32.

St. Georges Hotel – Table du Trappeur & Table du Pecheur 04 50 93 07 15

Two restaurants. The Trappeur is a favourite with good French food, although service can be slow and a bit pompous. Nice ambience. Two sittings 6:30 and 8:30pm. Table du Pecheur specialises in fish and good plat du jour but does have other dishes. We are told that they have excellent desserts. Main course €20-30.

Au Coeur de Megeve Hotel 04 50 21 25 30 This 3 star hotel has a cosy and charming restaurant serving good food. Two sittings 6:30 and 8:30pm Comfortable bar. The food is good but expensive. The service can be unfriendly and pompous. Main course €22-32.

Puck 04 50 21 06 61 Food was average – more snacky than evening meal probably more suited for lunch. Main course €19-27.

Delicium 04 50 21 37 15 Convenient for those staying at Rochebrune. We have had reports that the food is creative and interesting, although mainly pasta and pizza. The service can be slow. Main course:€22-42.

Le Comptoir d'Alice 04 50 58 71 31

Pleasant ambience and good and friendly service. Main course €19.50-32.

Enfants Terribles 04 50 21 20 02

Next to Hotel Mont Blanc. Savoyard specialties or French cooking. Very expensive. Main course €28-58.

Le Bistrot 04 50 21 32 74

Used to do traditional Savoyard cooking but now international food. Near Au Coeur de Megeve. Main course €24-38.

Cintra 04 50 21 02 60

Restaurant in the centre, varied menu. Main course €22.50-42.50.

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Le Restaunome 04 50 96 65 63

The dining room has a deal with the Hotel Au Vieux Moulin as well as being open to the public. Good food and service. Main course €15.50-39

Le Prioure 04 50 21 01 7

We found this expensive and disappointing the last time we went. Service is good and nice atmosphere. Main course €24-90 for 2.

Torrent 04 50 58 92 21

Try and get a table overlooking the stream. Very friendly. Main course €18-38.

La Sauvageonne "Chez Nano" 04 50 91 90 81

Expensive and out of town at the end of the Route de Rochebrune – 30 min walk or a taxi (check fare). Good food and lovely scenery. Possibly a lunch destination for non-skiers. Main courses €26-50.

Le Vieux Megeve. 04 50 21 16 44. Traditional Savoyard food, well presented.

Always busy. Main course €25-32.

L'Hibou Blanc 04 50 21 22 44 In the square by Allards. Formerly the Brasserie Centrale and now under new management Always busy. Main course €19-29. We had a disastrous meal there. The waiter was rude, the management ineffectual. Two of us ordered fillet steaks and were given something else. Not recommended.

Le Tig'rr Indochine.

Next door to the Torrent. We have not eaten there. Serves sushimi, sushi, maki. Main courses are €19-35.

Cafe 2 La Poste 04 50 21 02 18 On the roundabout by the Post Office. Small restaurant and always busy so advisable to book. Main course €14-29.50 Wine expensive.

Chamois 04 50 91 32 18

Owned by Sebastian and Stephanie from Le Torrent. Opposite the Hotel Rond Point. They do very good burgers. Main course €14-33.

Chalet Les Jumeaux 04 50 21 07 39 Restaurant and piano bar in the car park on the right beyond the Hotel Rond Point. Very expensive and food disappointing. Menu at €58. Main courses €28-48. Lively atmosphere. Pianist starts about 9 – 9.30

Chez Maria Just below the Chamois lift. They do omelettes, crepes and salads. They have a nice little garden. Main course €9.50-18.

Petit Cintra This is basically a coffee shop but they do breakfasts and snacks. Rather unfriendly.

Chez Nano Now under the ownership of La Sauvageonne. Mostly snack type of menu and a lot of dishes for sharing. Main course €12-17. We were told the portions were tiny and our guests went elsewhere for a pizza.

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La P'tite Creperie

Just off the main square. Serves, wraps, crepes and hamburgers plus dishes like tartiflette mainly to take away but there is a small restaurant. Main course €8.20-18.50.

M Le Bistrot. 04 50 21 41 09.

This is the restaurant at the 5 star hotel Le M de Megeve which used to be the Manège. It is near the St George's Hotel. Main courses €26-36.

Le Sommet 0450214109

The main restaurant for the hotel le M de Megeve. Main course €36-44.

St Nicholas 04 50 21 04 94

This is at the Hotel Au Coin Du Feu just down the road from the Sylvana. Prices are €20-37. Good food and nice ambience.

Le Cantine 0450349053

This is near the Jazz Club. Basically a bar but with food. Main course €20-35.

Le Spaggiari 0450988988

Another bar but serves pizzas from €8-14. It is next to the Tourist Office. We have had good reports of this.

Un Jour a Peyrassol 0450784459

This is just up from the Hotel Rond Point on the right hand side. It serves pizzas, burgers and pasta from €24-32..

Beef Lodge at Lodge Park Hotel 0450930503

As the name suggests, this mostly does steaks. Main course €29-190 for 2..

Le Gourmandier 0450210721

The restaurant at The Royal Rochebrune Hotel, just up from the Sylvana. Main course:€18.50-23.50
